The Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation was established in 1986 to introduce more young people to the game of golf and to nurture their skills and enjoyment of the sport. The objectives of JNJG are to establish and service a variety of golf programs for boys and girls that create pathways through the sport and cater for the beginner through to the elite. This scholarship provides an opportunity for a 2015 school leaver and member of JNJG, to take the next step into a career working within the golf industry, after completing the PGA IGI Diploma of Golf Management. The scholarship is for work internship with JNJG and its partners, and the PGA International Golf Institute (PGA IGI) course fees which involves the Diploma of Golf Management .

SELECTION CRITERIA

To be considered applicants MUST:

- Applied/accepted into PGA IGI Diploma of Golf Management (10459NAT) (RTO 31720)
- Applicant must undertake full-time studies, over 2 Trimesters (cannot be deferred)
- Applicant must not have previously completed a bachelor degree or higher level award.
- Applicant must be an Australian citizen/Permanent Resident
- Applicant must complete responses to the personal statement.
- Applicant provides two referees' reports.
- Applicant must be completing NSW HSC Year 12 in 2015 at time of application.

In considering the PGA IGI component you MUST also:

- Be applied/accepted into the PGA IGI component of studies.
- Have a handicap for males of 18 or better and 25 or better for females (including social golf handicaps)

PERSONAL STATEMENT

Provide in no more than two (2) typed pages (maximum 1000 words) the following statement including all the following:

- 1. The benefit you will derive from receiving a scholarship
- 2. How would you like to be involved within the golf industry in the future

INTERNSHIP CONDITIONS

- The 12 month internship period will commence on January 1st 2016 and conclude on December 31st 2016. Some flexibility will be provided on start and finish dates to suit the successful applicants personal situation.
- Part time work (non-paid) of 15 hours per week with JNJG during the internship period. This work will include various duties and tasks both in the JNJG office (located in Arncliffe) and also at various JNJG tournaments and events conducted across Sydney and New South Wales. (Assistance will be provided when extended travel and accommodation/meals are required to attend tournaments and events). Flexibility on when these hours are undertaken will be provided to the successful applicant based on their individual study, training and competitive schedules.
- Undertake part time (paid and not paid) work during the scholarship period with JNJG's partners. This work may include industry experience in the hospitality and corporate sectors.
- The successful applicant will be a required to pay a \$5,000 refundable scholarship fee to JNJG. The scholarship fee will be fully
 refunded to the applicant by JNJG at the completion of the scholarship period based upon successful graduation of the Diploma of
 Golf Management and fulfilling the internship conditions. (The fee will be held in a trust account. Payment options are available and
 will be discussed with the successful applicant)

REFEREES' REPORTS

You must supply two **current** referees' reports outlining your suitability for Jack Newton Junior Golf PGA IGI Scholarship, the PGA IGI component would request, at least one must be from a golf club official or PGA of Australia member (eg. Golf Club Manager, Golf Coach, Junior Club Coordinator). The referee should provide information on yourself demonstrating your motivation and commitment to be successful for your studies and future career.

Referees reports need to be attached to your application form at the time of submission.
